

1.	<b>Nature of Work</b>	The murder of unknown person whose body found near hotel Devesh Panjab is Successfully open.

6.	<b><u>Brief of the work done :-</u></b>	<p>Bandra's famous paanwala Shivprasad alias Munna Chaurasia's son Nikunj was found murdered. A crime was registered at Kashmirira Police Station vide Cr.No. I 670/2016, U/S 302, 201 of IPC Dated 23/11/2016. The Thane Rural's Local Crime Branch nailed three people involved in the incident. The arrested accused have been identified as 1) Kamlesh Sahani from Nalasopara 2) Rupesh Saha 3) Mantu Patel from Narkatiyaganj, Bihar. Investigations have revealed that Nikunj was murdered after thorough planning and the motive behind the gruesome act was to loot the gold ornaments and cash that he had on him.</p> <p><b>Among the three accused</b> Rupesh became friend with Nikunj around five years ago. Rupesh's brother Santosh used to work as a security guard in a building just behind the at the Bandra (w) paan shop. Whenever Santosh visited his native place, Rupesh took his place as a guard at the building. Rupesh was well aware that Nikunj used to wear a lot of gold. However, the plan to kill him was hatched by Rupesh's friend Kamlesh. As per the plan, Rupesh met Nikunj late in the evening on November 22, near at his paan shop while Mantu and Kamlesh waited at a distance. Rupesh offered him to come for a drink at Banstand. After having the drink, which was spiked with sedatives, Nikunj started feeling drowsy. Thereafter, the trio hired a taxi and took him to Godhbunder road, where he was murdered and dump near buch of bushes at Hotel Devesh Panjab on Mumbai Ahemedabad road.</p> <p>Nikunj resisted when the trio tried to rob him, but was easily overpowered by them. They smashed his head and chest with a heavy stone, which eventually led to his death. The gold and cash that Nikunj was carrying were not recovered from the spot. Hence, we started investigations suspecting robbery to be the prime motive behind the murder.</p> <p>In the course of the probe, the team lead by Asst. Police Inspector, Mr. Praful Ramesh Wagh who work at Kashmirira Unit of Local Crime Branch, Thane Rural parallel investigate the case, but did not get a clue till they came across a CCTV footage showing a suspect talking to Nikunj hours before the murder. It was only after team circulated the footage among various police stations but nothing had helped to solve the case. LCB Team also collected the cell ID's from seven different spots and collect all dump data where Nikunj went on November 22. While the analysis of the dump data LCB team interrogated over 402 people in whom 68 numbers were found suspected. The LCB team analysis those 68 mobile No's CDR, in that investigation team got a mobile no who travelling with Nikunj at 22:36 hrs at Mount Merry and 23:58 at the spot where body was found. The</p>

Investigation team keeps that suspected Mobile no on radar and investigates by that angle. That Mobile no. leads towards person Kamlesh Sah who was seen into the CCTV footage where he speaking to Nikunj, just hours before the latter's murder. "We have considered him as a prime suspect since he was the last person Nikunj spoke to before he went missing. The suspect is also absconding ever since the body was found. Further investigation team got information about Kamlesh Sah was spotted in Nalasopara where picked up Kamlesh from the area for interrogations, during which he confessed to his involvement in the murder. Further probe revealed that two others, who were part of the crime, had fled to Narkatiyaganj in Bihar. A team was immediately sent there and arrested test of both. The police have recovered a gold chain, cell phone and the keys of Nikunj's bike from the accused.
